Brown County, Indiana Historic Little Nashville Opry Cancels All Shows

The Little Nashville Opry's recent fire has totally destroyed the historic building including all of the memorabilia collected over the years including photos, murals, and the hundreds of musician's signatures collected along the back walls of the venue. In addition, the sound and lights, musician's instruments and the box office, which was located in the front of the building, were also ruined and all records were lost.

Due to the magnitude of the loss and the overwhelming decisions that need to be made over the next few weeks and months the management has announced that they are cancelling all shows scheduled for the remainder of the year. Offers have poured in from venues throughout Brown County, offering to work with the Opry to keep the scheduled performances and the tradition of the Opry alive but after discussing alternate locations with the artists; they realized that the logistics of rescheduling the performances were just too enormous to deal with at this time.

The Opry is requesting that all ticket holders who are requesting a refund follow these procedures:

~ If you have purchased tickets through Ticketmaster, contact Ticketmaster directly for a refund.

~ If you have purchased tickets through the Opry box office, please mail your tickets and/or verification of your ticket purchase along with your contact information and a stamped, self-addressed envelope to:

The management wanted everyone to understand that their box office was completely destroyed in the fire along with all of their paperwork and office files. They appreciate everyone's support and kind words, and to have patience as they work through the issues during the next several weeks.
